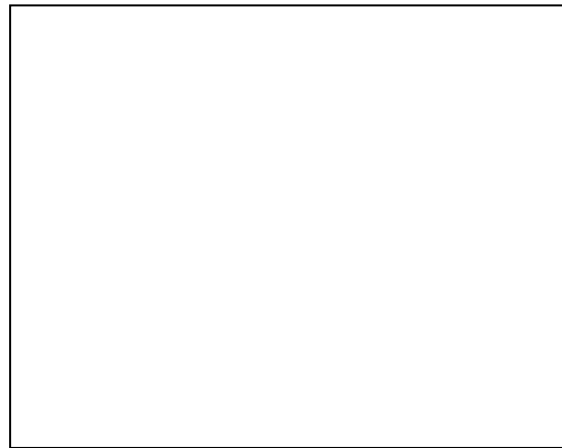
Answer.1. There are five important seasons. They are: Summer, Monsoon, Autumn, Winter and spring.

a). Summer – In summer, the sun is hot and bright and the air is warm and dry. The days are longer than the nights. It is best to stay indoors and drink plenty of liquids.

b). Rainy season- The rainy season is known as monsoon. It is the wettest season of the year. Rains make the crops grow well. Rain water fills up the rivers and lakes.


