In this regard all DEA participants (Bronze, Silver and Gold) are requested to prepare at least 5 packages of food and other essentials to distribute among those in dire need of them.

Each package may include the following items:

1. Rice (5 kg)
2. Lentils (1 kg)
3. Potato (2 kg)
4. Soybean oil (1 litre)
5. Sugar (1 kg)
6. Soap/ hand wash (1)

Once prepared, the packages can be given to the people in need in your own area or nearest to your home. If possible, please send the photograph and the name of the people whom you helped. Please strictly follow the rules to protect yourself and then help others. Safety first.

Packages can also be sent to their respective school campuses. The school will then organise its distribution. One can also donate packages through Jaago using the Foodpanda app. The screenshot of the receipt from Foodpanda can be sent to the DEA coordinator.

This contribution will be considered as a social service for your award criteria. **Awardees can do it individually or in groups.**

Awardees are also encouraged to use social media to discuss and come up with ideas that would best solve this problem. They can think of other creative activities to help, keeping in mind the current situation.

In light of this difficult time, the DEA awardees are expected to show their dedication, commitment and leadership skills thus becoming role models for others in the community.
